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What To Bring

Please bring the following items with you for Pilot Instructor Training or Transition Training*:

- ✓ Several Flight Suits (Depending on how often you want to do laundry)
- ✓ Flight Boots
 - Helmet/Oxygen Mask
 - G-Suit
 - Gloves
 - Life Support Records
 - Flying Evaluation Folder (FEF)
- Medical Records
- Flight Records
 - To include: Altitude chamber training (TARF) documentation (AF Form 702), CURRENT and ACTIVE Aeronautical Orders, and CURRENT AF Form 1042
- Physiological Training Card
- Proof of Last Centrifuge (If you've been)
- Travel Orders (3 Copies, minimum)

- AF Form 63, Active Duty Service Commitment Counseling Statement

Most of these are "show-stoppers." If you show up without them, there will be a delay in your training while you wait for them to be mailed from your home unit. The more prepared you are when you show up, the more you can concentrate on your training.
